I was delighted to be asked to judge the Special Puppy event and would like to say Thankyou to the hardworking committee members for their warm welcome and hospitality, I really enjoyed my day.

Class A - Special Puppy Dog 6 to 8 months (4)

1) Pynegar – Berwynfa Toy Story – 8 months.

Stunning red and white boy, there was nothing not to like. Square, compact body with correct angulation, clean head, with good wide mouth, nicely arched neck, level top line, correct tail set, plenty of bone and tight feet. Moved with purpose, well balanced for one so young. **BPD BPIS**

2) Holmes – Jamonik Rizzini Emilio – 6 months.

Brindle and white, very pleasing compact shape, clean head, with dark eyes and good mouth, arched neck on well laid shoulders, evident fore chest, good bone, tight feet and curve of stifle, moved well for his young handler.

Class D - Special Puppy Bitch 6 to 8 months (5 - 1 absent)

1) Huckerby & Dowell – Greenawell Razamataz for Norwilbeck Bellchime – 7 months. Very stylish 7 month old young lady, nice well shaped head with expressive dark eyes, correct ear set, lip placement and good teeth. Arched neck flowed into well laid shoulders, clean top line, correct tail set and curve of stifle, very tight feet, moved out well.

2) Pynegar – Berwynfa Tit for Tat – 8 months.

Another lovely bitch from this breeder, red brindle and white in excellent condition, well balanced, plenty of bone, a nicely shaped head with correct bite, ear set, bite and lip placement, curved neck flowing into well laid shoulders with level top line, good spring of rib and nice curve of stifle, very tight feet. Moved with ease around the ring, gave me a lot to think about. Close call.

Class F - Special Puppy Bitch 10 to 12 months (3)

1) Beardsell & Van Beck – Newlaithe Ginger Nut – 11 months.

Red and White very clean headed girl in a very shiny coat, correct ear set, kind eyes set in this feminine face with good muzzle, correct bite and teeth. Curved neck flowed into well laid back shoulders, level top line, good curve of stifle, very good bone and rear quarters. Slightly down on her pasterns, but strode round the ring with plenty of drive.

2) Bate – Lullmire Rebel Rebel – 11 months.

Lovely, calm well balanced brindle and white boxer in great condition, very nice head, bright eyes, correct ear set, very good lip placement, teeth, chin, muzzle and stop. Clean neck, well placed shoulders, level top line and correct tail set. Moved well for her novice handler who I am sure will get years of pleasure from showing this lovely girl.
