I didn't find ant outstanding problems with our breed today and overall the quality was very good. However, we do have some ongoing issues; over wrinkling on the skull, narrow mouths and flapping pasterns on the move.

#### Minor Puppy Bitch (8, 1 Abs)

1<sup>st</sup> Drinkwater's Maranseen Seduction at Sulez

Promising b/w 7½ months well grown, good length of foreleg and well-placed shoulders. She has excellent bone and substance but still presents a feminine smart clean outline with good length of neck. Clean sweep of underline and correct rear angulation. Pretty oncoming head with width and depth of muzzle. Good rise to clean skull, lovely expression. Has the essentials to build on as she matures. Moved well, confident and composed young lady. Best Puppy Bitch

2<sup>nd</sup> Miller & Seeney's Maranseen Sparkle at Walkon

B/w 7 months, another lovely puppy of promise. Head has balance muzzle to skull with good rise, good mouth and lip placement. The best of expression from dark well shaped eyes. Good length of foreleg, clean well arched neck and into well laid shoulders. Good topline and turn of stifle. Not as composed as 1 on the move. I would say these two will change places many times.

#### Puppy Bitch (11, 2 Abs)

1st Slattery's Sleipnir Shadow Maiden

B/w almost 12 months. Very pleasing general appearance. Has a well-developed body for her age. Good neck length into well laid shoulders, good topline held on the move. Strong muscled quarters with good turn of stifle. Moved with drive and fore extension. Head is well defined. Width and depth of muzzle in balance to skull, dark eyes of good shape. A lovely puppy.

2<sup>nd</sup> Jones & Charles' Charlons Perseus

R/w of 10 months, smaller build than 1. Good bone, compact frame showing balance throughout. She has a good depth of brisket, evident forechest and short strong back, good turn of stifle with well-muscled quarters. Head is balanced with strength of muzzle and good mouth. Lovely dark eyes. Showed and moved well.

3<sup>rd</sup> Pearce & Francis' Longsdale Heart Of Gold

#### Junior Bitch (5, 1 Abs)

1<sup>st</sup> Huggin's Daervlish Elevation

B/w of quality, stands on tight feet, good front and layback of shoulders. Clean underline with tuck-up produces a smart profile with a good length of neck and correct rear angulation. Lovely head, balanced throughout with a well-padded muzzle, good stop and clean skull. Good mouth and lip placement, dark eyes portraying a delightful expression. Moved very well.

2<sup>nd</sup> Beardsell, Van-Beck & O'Neill's Newlaithe Just Meghan

R/w substantial bitch with good bone but still portrays a picture of femininity and balance. Good front and depth of brisket, short strong back, good rear angulation and well-muscled quarters. Typical well-balanced head and good strength of muzzle. Well-shaped dark eyes, excellent expression and a good mouth. Moved with drive.

#### Yearling Bitch (6)

1<sup>st</sup> Brown & Hitchings' Winuwuk Looking For Love (AI)

B/w of quality. Loved her head, clean and feminine of excellent balance and finish of foreface. Good stop and rise of skull, well-padded muzzle and good mouth. Beautiful dark expressive eyes. Smart square outline, strong arched neck into well laid shoulders. Good length of foreleg and upper arm. Correct rear angulation drove her out well on the move. Last 4 for the CC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Mair's CH Vandenrob Tisoni at Glenauld

R/w worthy CH of quality, lovely outline with no exaggerations, long arched neck, good shoulders and topline. Strong quarters that drove her around with a positive action on the move. Head is well balanced muzzle to skull with good mouth and lip placement. Soft alert expression from dark well shaped eyes.

#### Novice Bitch (10, 2 Abs)

1st Beardsell & Van-Beck's Newlaithe Pureoco

B/w smart and compact in outline, has good angles and balance. Good front with good depth of brisket, well developed quarters and turn of stifle. Moved well maintaining her profile. Typical head, good width and depth of muzzle in balance to skull. Good mouth and lip placement. Dark well shaped eyes.

2<sup>nd</sup> Pynegar & Loasby's Berwynfa Oh La La

B/w with good body properties, well-muscled throughout. Good front, evident chest, strong short back and well-developed quarters. Typical head with good finish and balance. Dark eyes, nice expression, good mouth and lip placement. Moved well with drive.

#### **Debutante Bitch (7)**

1<sup>st</sup> Jones & Charles' Winuwuk Justify My Love at Charlons

B/w lovely smart, strong well-made bitch with good musculation. She moves well with excellent drive and extension. Good angulation for and aft, short strong back, good topline and tailset. Head is well done but most pleasing with good balance muzzle to skull. Good mouth, correct eye shape with a lovely soft expression.

2<sup>nd</sup> Henderson's Taranut Medea

Dark b/w smaller than 1 with a stylish compact outline. Clean front on tight feet. Good length of neck and level topline. Head is well finished and balanced with a good stop and rise of skull. Dark expressive eyes. Moved well 3<sup>rd</sup> McVay's Daervlish Love Rescue Me at Lochsunart

#### **Graduate Bitch (8, 2 Abs)**

1st Mair's Vandenrob Vanessa via Glenauld

B/w elegant well-made youngster with a lovely head of excellent proportions, strong well-padded muzzle with width and depth. Good stop with lovely rise to clean skull. Best of expression from dark well shaped eyes. Good mouth. Strong arched neck, clean front with good length of foreleg and upper arm into good lay of shoulder. Wide well angulated stifle. Moved with a strong positive action from all angles. Showed very well. Pleased to award her RCC and in agreement of my co judge Reserve Best in Show.

2<sup>nd</sup> Beardsell & Van-Beck's Newlaithe Wandara

B/w, a very neat bitch, super arch and length of neck. She has a balance of body throughout, short back and strong topline. Brisket depth balanced in relation to foreleg. Good angles front and rear. A little apprehensive on the move today. Clean feminine head with good balance of muzzle to skull. Excellent expression, good mouth and lip placement.

3<sup>rd</sup> Flintoff & Woolliss' Boxania Midnight Spice

#### Post Graduate Bitch (9, 2 Abs)

1<sup>st</sup> Seeney's Maranseen Encore

B/w standing on tight small feet on a well assembled front. Evident forechest, short, strong back, good topline and tailset. Clean underline. Covered the ground well on the move with a strong driving action and clean front movement. Lovely well-balanced head that has strength of muzzle and good rise of skull. Dark expressive eyes, good mouth and bite. A lovely bitch who showed very well.

2<sup>nd</sup> McCarthy & Gething's Sunvalley Careless Heart at Jeddhi

B/W she has the best of expression from dark correct shaped eyes. Very well-balanced head with width and depth of muzzle, wide underjaw and mouth. Good stop and rise to clean skull. Compact in outline with depth of brisket, clean underline to well developed quarters. Moved with a good driving action.

#### Limit Bitch (14, 6 Abs)

1st Fay-Smith's Lorrosa Shine Like A Diamond

Dark b/w a lovely bitch in top condition with a glossy coat. Good musculation throughout her strong feminine body. Clean elegant neck. Good front with balanced foreleg height to depth of brisket. Short back, clean underline to muscular quarters and good turn of stifle. She has a well-balanced head with strength of muzzle, good rise to a clean skull. Good mouth and lip placement. Dark expressive eyes. Moved with a strong driving action and length of stride. In the last 4 for the CC.

2<sup>nd</sup> Wilson's Thorpaige Kiss Chase

Lots to like about this b/w bitch. Lovely typical head, wide well-padded muzzle with balanced depth and good mouth, clean skull and dark expressive eyes of correct shape. Presents a picture of substance with elegance, good length of neck, firm back, well angulated fore and aft. Her well-muscled quarters produced a free driving action on the move.

#### Open Bitch (5)

I awarded her Best Puppy at Leeds so it was good to see she has fulfilled her early promise. ### Veteran Bitch (8, 4 Abs)

1st Beardsell & Van-Beck's Newlaithe On Design JW

B/w 7½ obviously enjoying her day out. She was on her toes and showing really well. She still has a lovely clean compact outline, evident chest, clean front and good angulation front and rear. Head is clean and well defined with no evidence of coarseness. Moved well and with enthusiasm.

B/w 9¾ years in great condition, she still has a clean underline and tuck-up, a credit to her owner. Good front and rear angulation with good musculation for her age. Pretty feminine head with good balance of muzzle to skull. Moved well and seemed to enjoy herself.
